

## Children and Young People's plans

Brief run down of how disabled young people's services are represented as priority in the Local Authority plans.

Local Authority	Rating	Notes
Anglesey	Average	Disabled children are mentioned regularly in the plan. However, no extra resources are allocated for improving services.
Blaenau Gwent	Good	Disabled children are prioritised and there is a clear set of outlined actions to improve services and conditions for disabled children.
Bridgend	Good	Real commitments put forward. Disabled children are definitely a priority.
Caerphilly	Good	Disabled children are a priority and recognition is made that services will need significant change to come up to expected standards.
Cardiff	Good	Lots of mention of disabled children and improvement of services. Not just an afterthought.
Carmarthenshire	Poor	Little mention of disabled children. Two action points to address standards of services but little else within the plan.
Ceredigion	Poor	Little commitment to disabled children.
Conwy	Good	Plan addresses several key areas, such as access to leisure with commitment to develop strategies.
Denbighshire	Good	Disabled children highlighted with partnership established with key actions to improving services.
Flintshire	Good	Makes disabled children a priority. Commitments are a little vague.
Gwynedd	Good	Disabled children given a priority with acknowledgement made that it is 'critical' to improve services.
Merthyr Tydfil	Good	Good mapping of existing services, highlighting disabled children as a priority with key plans in place.
Monmouthshire	Good	Takes account of the majority of DCMW aims. Makes disabled children and young people a priority.
Neath Port Talbot	Average	There are some key actions to improve existing services but disabled children are not a priority.
Newport	Good	Commitment to integration and improvement of services. Access to services is a priority.
Pembrokeshire	Average	There is acknowledgement that services are not great, but, disabled children are clustered with other vulnerable children and do not have priority status in the plan.
Powys	Good	Disabled children are among the core aims. Commitments to improve access, support and leisure.
Rhondda Cynon Taff	Good	The plan make disabled children a priority. It addresses important asks within the campaign.
Swansea	Average	There are some targeted actions for disabled children. However, disabled children fall under a broader heading of specific groups and there are many of these.
Torfaen	Good	The plan outlines disabled children as a priority and recognises that the key is joined up working with other partnerships.
Vale of Glamorgan	Average	Several mentions of disabled children but mostly it mostly lists external agencies. Nothing concrete.
Wrexham	Good	Inclusive of disabled children and addresses several of the campaigns aims. Disabled children are highlighted as priority.
